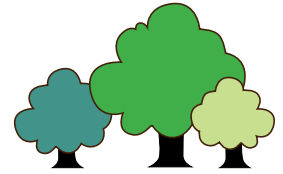

### Our owls

Have you heard the Great Horned Owls calling at night or very early in the morning? This species is the largest native US owl and they live in our Glen. They often choose abandoned nests of crows or other large birds to raise their own young in. If you hear the persistent scolding calls of other birds, those sounds can pinpoint the location of an owl, which can be otherwise difficult to see because of the cryptic color and the pattern of their feathers.

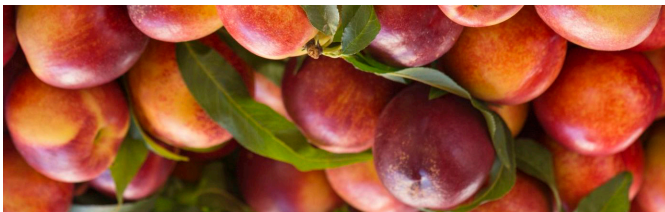
## Pauline, Pauline, Nectarine
