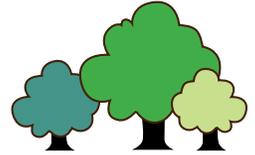

I, of course, would return the drive after downloading. I could even scan some prints and put them on the viewer as well, if you only have photos in a non-digital format."



## Thrill

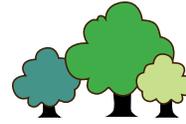
I get a thrill when I open the door and hear a woodpecker in a tree! (Sandy, sp. 11)
