


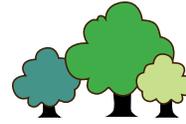
**Our Board of Directors**

**Trash Talk**

"The regional Resident Owned Parks (ROP) quarterly meeting was held at Seacliff Mobile Home Park in Feb. Joyce (sp. 9) and Pete (sp. 10) attended from Sorrento Oaks. The guest speakers from our Dept of Public Works gave us a detailed review of how trash is handled in this county. They are wizards of trash and gave us interesting information about handling our trash: recycling, composting, and green waste. Plastics are ubiquitous, requiring different handling for different kinds. Unfortunately, plastic bags cannot be recycled at this time so put them in the trash. Food waste takes up a lot of space in our landfill: estimates are as much as 40%, and pickup of it is coming to our county soon. We have mixed recycling so make sure all items are rinsed, cleaned and turned upside down to dry and then put into the blue recycle bin. If moisture gets onto paper, it softens it and contaminates the whole load."


Fun while it lasted, but now, with lack of interest, Handmade is discontinued. Nancy J (sp. 33)
